NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following central counting place has been legally designated by the Registrar of Voters of the County of Sierra for the Statewide Direct Primary Election to be held on June 5, 2018.

The Registrar of Voters also, hereby notifies all interested organizations that the verifying of signatures on vote-by-mail ballots cast for the Statewide Direct Primary Election will commence on May 7, 2018 and will continue thereafter in the County Elections Office at 100 Courthouse Square, Room 11, Downieville, California. On May 30, 2018, or at any time thereafter, the opening and processing of vote-by-mail ballots will commence. This process will continue until all election results are tabulated and the election is certified. The process is done in a manner which insures the secrecy of all ballots.

The processing of vote-by-mail ballots is open to members of the public for observation. Observers shall not interfere with the orderly processing and counting of vote-by-mail ballots, including touching or handling of the ballots or envelopes.
