

ATTENTION VOTERS

The Sierra County Registrar of Voters would like to remind all voters that the Statewide Special Election will be held on November 4, 2025. All Sierra County voting precincts have been designated as “all mailed” ballot precincts for this election. This means that all Sierra County voters will be receiving a vote-by-mail ballot. Our office will be mailing out the vote-by-mail ballots on October 6, 2025.

Remember the last day to register to vote for the November 4, 2025, Statewide Special Election is October 20, 2025. If you move to a new residence address within the county or need to register to vote after this deadline, you will have the opportunity to register and vote on a conditional provisional ballot by visiting the Sierra County Clerk’s Office. Return your ballot by mail. Vote-by-mail ballots will be counted if postmarked on or before Election Day and received by the Sierra County Clerk's Office no later than 7 days after Election Day.

Return your ballot in person. A drop box will be available at the Loyalton City Hall Auditorium from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day or you can bring your ballot to the Sierra County Clerk's Office in Downieville. Your ballot must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
